Literary Britain

The story of our Railways

Visit the iconic "small railways of Wales" and learn how and why they were constructed in mountain terrain – visit the National Railway Museum – see preservation steam trains that still offer public transport services - learn how the Victorian railway builders brought economic and social revolution to the UK



Go back in time by 4500 years to learn how early mankind lived in Britain - see magnificent Stonehenge Avebury and the long barrow at West Kennet – marvel at the Uffington White Horse, carved into a chalk hillside - see stone houses built about 2500 BC with internal furniture and fittings and flushing toilets - learn how people in the stone age were more advanced than perhaps we understand

Scientific Discoveries

Follow the lives and work of famous scientists such as Isaac Newton, William Herschel, Joseph Lister, John Flamsteed, Humphrey Davy, for example, or more recently, James Watson and Francis Crick See where they lived and where they worked – visit exhibitions describing their discoveries and learn how their discoveries impacted on the daily lives of ordinary people

History of World War II

Visit Winston Churchill's WWII Cabinet War Rooms and learn about the course of the Second World War - Imperial War Museum - visit Slapton Sands where US and Allied forces practised for the D Day landings and where a terrible tragedy unfolded - visit Bletchley Park, where Alan Turing broke the Enigma code - find out how Londoners lived during the Blitz - visit HMS Belfast, permanently moored in the Thames as a memorial to the sailors of both World Wars – enjoy a lecture at the Air transport Auxiliary Museum (the only active organisation that allowed women to participate in the War effort)
