


EUROPEAN WONDERS

Day 01 Madrid Welcome to Madrid! Upon arrival at the airport, we shall be waiting to transfer you to your hotel. Check the informative panels in the hotel reception area for the welcome meeting with your guide to receive information about the circuit. we transfer to the Egyptian Debod temple, Plaza de España and Gran Vía; a vibrant district where you can dine at your preferred restaurant.

Day 02 Madrid. The day starts about 08.30 hrs with a comprehensive tour through the centre of Madrid including Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, the Gate of Alcalá, Plaza de Colón and Plaza Mayor Admission to Las Ventas Bullring included. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon. At sunset we transfer to Plaza de Oriente.

Day 03. Madrid - Zaragoza - Poblet - Montserrat We depart early in the morning from Madrid., we pause our journey in ZARAGOZA. Afterwards the group will have free time to visit the Basilica del Pilar and enjoy the city centre. Later, we make our way to Cataluña to the Monastery of Poblet, one of the best preserved medieval monasteries in the world (entrance and guided tour included). We then go on to the Monastery of Montserrat where we include a ride on the rack train for the fantastic views this gives.

Day 04. Barcelona Today we will get to know Barcelona. informative city tour with a local expert. We visit the city's historic central area with the Gothic neighbourhood see and photograph La Sagrada Família basilica; entry ticket to "Poble Espanyol" (meaning "Spanish Village. Free time to explore the city on your own. In the evening we provide transfer to Las Ramblas and Plaza Catalunya area,

Day 05. Barcelona - Paris. travel on a high-speed train to Paris. Visit to the Montmartre district. This neighborhood is known for its painters, artists, and its cabarets... Sit down to dinner and enjoy a magical night. We will ascend by cable car to the hill and admire the spectacular view of Paris from the top.

Day 06. Paris. A scenic guided tour to discover the history, main boulevards and the breathtaking monuments of Paris. We end the visit at the Eiffel Tower (ticket admission included). End your visit with a boat cruise along the River Seine. Enjoy a free afternoon to explore as you choose. At sunset transfer to the "Quartier Latin", a very picturesque area of the historic centre where you can enjoy dinner with a wide variety of international cuisines.

Day 07 Paris. We go to the centre of Paris, to the area of the Louvre Museum. Free time. If you wish we can accompany you to Benlux, one of the most complete and best-known perfumeries in Paris. Rest of the day free. You can take an optional excursion to enjoy in Eurodisney.

Day 08. Paris - Noyers - Beaune - Lyon. We travel to the centre of France to the wine famous Bourgogne region, A stop in NOYERS, a small medieval town classified amongst the prettiest places in France. After this we will visit BEAUNE in the centre of the Bourgogne region where its streets full of flowers, its hospice and its wine museum can be reminders of your trip.

Day 09. Lyon - Geneva - Zurich. We travel to Switzerland. GENEVA. With our guide, go to the Palais des Nations (the United Nations headquarters in Europe) and then to the beautiful "Jardin Anglais" with its flower clock, and admire the "Jet d'Eau", the tallest fountain in Europe, we will continue through Switzerland passing the beautiful Leman and Neuchatel Lakes.

Day 10. Zurich - Rapperswil - Zurich. stroll in the most populated city of Switzerland, the financial and cultural capital of the country. After this we will board a boat for a trip on Zurich lake. We get off in RAPPERSWIL, a small and highly picturesque village overlooked by its medieval castle. return to Zurich by train, and will see the efficiency and punctuality of the Swiss Railways. Enjoy an evening in the historic centre, next to the lake, Where you can dine at your favorite restaurant.

Day 11. Zurich - Grindelwald - Lucerne - Zurich. watch the Breathtaking scenery in the region of Interlaken. GRINDELWALD where we will have time for a coffee before taking the cable car (ticket included) up to Grindelwald first. Lunch included. After that we continue to LUCERNE, one of the most beautiful cities in Switzerland. Time at the end of the day to explore.

Day 12. Zurich - Burglen- Morcote - Como - Milan. We travel to BURGLEN, the tiny village where William Tell was born, we shall see the chapel of the XVI century with paintings illustrating his life. we reach the enchanting little town of MORCOTE, with its houses made of stone, and covered with flowers. We enter Italy and stop in COMO, on the shores of its lake. The city highlights the Gothic Cathedral. Arrival in MILAN where our guide will take us to the impressive Duomo Square.

Day 13. Milan - Pisa - Rome. We continue towards PISA. On a little tourist train we will travel to the Piazza Dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), there will be time to admire the Leaning Tower of Pisa.

Day 14. Rome. have a scenic tour of the city, and enter the tiny state of the Vatican. You will be able to visit St. Peter's Basilica. And we also included admission to the Roman Coliseum. In the evening we provide transport to the Via Cavour area.

Day 15. Rome. After breakfast, end of our services.
